The Board's responsibilities include the annual review and approval of the social activities' budgets of the two community Recreation Activity Committees along with receiving monetary concerns and requests that affect the improvements in the two communities.

Please use the "Resident Input Form" for your suggestions and concerns. They are available in the clubhouses, from board members and in this publication. There are input drop boxes in the hallways of both clubhouses to receive the forms or give them to a board member. All input is kept confidential.

The Advisory Board looks forward to receiving your suggestions and ideas for the benefit of our communities.

## DISCUSSION ON INPUT FORMS RECEIVED FROM RESIDENTS

- Approval of the CLVII social Budget for June thru December, 2025.

• Among the items for discussion with Katie Dell at the March meeting included a review of past and continuing items within our "discussion with management" items including:

- \* Reviewing CLV Rules and Regulations
- \* The continuing concern of resident vehicle and delivery truck speeding through the communities.
- \* CLVI sewage system/pump smell
- Resident Input Forms received
- \* CLVII: Purchase of solar paneled speed detectors—not recommended by Board and Management.
- \* CLVII: Request for nighttime lighting at CLVII pickleball courts: this is a liability issue and will not be provided.
- \* CLVI: Concern about entrance gate operations being understood by residents and guests. Management will provide clear directions when the gates are operational.
- \* CLVI: Concern regarding grill cleaning. After using the grill, they are to be cleaned.
- \* CLVI: Concern regarding the game room Chairs. The wheels will be removed and "leg lifts" will be attached to bring the chairs to a 20-inch height. If this does not resolve the concern, the purchase of new chairs will be previewed for the 2026 budget.
- \* CLVI: A location for the bocce ball court will be studied

SCAM ALERT

Grandparent and Family Scams

Here's how they work:

You get a call: "Grandma, I need money for bail." Or maybe an email from someone claiming to be your brother or a friend who says they're in trouble. They need money for a medical bill. Or some other kind of emergency. The caller says it's urgent — and tells you to **keep it a secret.**

But is the caller who you think it is? Scammers are good at pretending to be someone they're not. They can be convincing: **sometimes using information from social networking sites**, or hacking into your loved one's email account, all to make it seem more real. And they'll pressure you to send money before you have time to think.

Here's what to do:

1. **Stop.** Check it out. Look up your family member's phone number yourself and **call another family member** to check out the story.
2. **Pass this information on to a friend.** You may not have gotten one of these calls, but chances are, you know someone who will get one — if they haven't already.
